

Eleventh Biennial Conference Report

17th -18th November 2022:- The Eleventh Biennial Conference of Indian Association for Asian and Pacific Studies was held hybrid mode in association with ASEAN Studies Centre, Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok, Thailand. The main theme of the Conference was- “Asia-Pacific from Past to Present: Bonding and Challenges” .The two day conference was sub divided into 8 major themes with 10 parallel sessions

The major thematic sessions are as follows:-

- Religion, Society and Culture: Asia in View
- Geopolitics, Geo strategic and Geo-economic Dimensions in Indo-Pacific
- Covid and its Impact in Asia
- Dynamics of Multilateral Co-operation in the Indo-Pacific Region
- ASEAN: Success and Challenges
- Gendered Asia: Issues and Challenges
- Thailand: From the Past to the Era of Indo-Pacific
- Sustainable Development Goals and Indo-Pacific

The keynote address of the conference was delivered by Prof S.D. Muni and the valedictory session of the conference was delivered by Prof Joefe.B. Santarita. Apart from the keynote and valedictory session there was a special plenary session on “Thirty years of INDIA-ASEAN RELATIONS’ which was chaired by Prof SuratHorachaikul, Director, Indian Studies Center, Chulalongkorn and the speakers were Prof Dr Lipi Ghosh, Prof Suchandra Ghosh, Prof PitiSrisangnam and Dr Anasua Basu Ray Chaudhury, the session mainly delved about India’s relation with Southeast Asia from the historical to contemporary times.
